#### CRAFTS WITH SUSAN

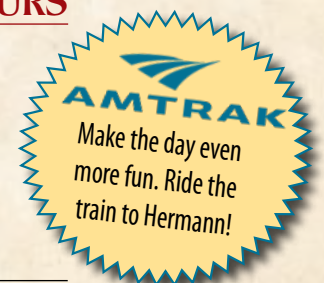
After lunch, it's time to get creative. Susan supplies everything you need so both grandparents and grandchildren have something to take home. *\$4 per person*
