| 10:00 AM | Hermann Farm - Living History Tour www.hermannfarm.com | Honoring the early life and works of George Husmann this guided tour tells the story of the early life and works of George Husmann and of many German immigrants who settled in the lower Missouri River Valley in the mid-1800's. Includes an open air tram ride over the rolling hills. |

| 2:00 PM OPT 2 | Deutschheim State Historic Site | The guided tour of the two homes captures the culture and heritage of the German people who migrated to Missouri in the mid to late 19th century. Unique German items such as springerle cookie molds, scherenschnitte and German pop-up cards are available in the Deutschheim visitor center gift shop. |
| 3:30 PM OPT 1 | Hermannhof Winery www.hermannhof.com | Enjoy wine and cheese tasting before embarking on a Self-Guided Tour of Hermannhof's stone cellars. The charming brick superstructures are among the 100 early Hermann buildings placed on the National Register of Historic places by the Federal government. |
| 3:30 PM OPT 2 | Espresso Laine www.espressolaine.com | Stop by for a mid-afternoon pick me up. Espresso Laine specializes in unique blends of high quality, freshly ground beans that are custom roasted and available in a variety of flavors. |
| 3:30 PM OPT 3 | Self-Guided River Front Walking Tour | Historic Landmarks & Highlights include: Buildings from the late 1800's, Statue of Arminius (Hermann the German), the River Front Museum, the Gasconade County Courthouse, and much more. Maps include information about each point of interest along the way are provided. |
