12:05pm - Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis
1:00pm - Tour of Cathedral Basilica, Museum, & Shrine

Built from 1907 to 1916, the **Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis** is a one-of-a-kind work of art. With its lofty vaults & radiant mosaics, the sheer scale of beauty is a thing of awe. More than a dozen architects' and artisans' concepts coalesced into well-integrated & harmonious whole. It's nickname is "**Rome of the West**".



2:30pm - Tour of Anheuser Busch Brewery

Explore the **Anheuser-Busch** brewery campus, visit the world-famous **Clydesdales** up close, and taste beer straight from the finishing cellars.

6:00pm - Unwind with drinks at Grand Hall Union Station

This historic landmark boasts a **stunning light show** projected onto the 65-foot arched ceiling every hour. Savor the spectacle while sipping a handcrafted cocktail before heading out for a **delicious dinner** at **Ballpark Village**.

† Day Two: Perryville



8:00am - Depart St. Louis and travel **80 miles** south on **Interstate 55** to **Perryville** (approximately 1.5 hours)

9:30am - Arrive at the **National Shrine**.
(Optional: **Hoeckele's donuts & coffee**)

10:00am - Visit the **National Shrine of Our Lady of the Miraculous Medal**. Nationally recognized, the Shrine is the first consecrated church west of the Mississippi River since 1818. Explore the beautiful paintings and intricate design work adorning the interior with a guided tour.

Interact with the relics of the **True Cross**, **Last Supper Table**, and **Via Dolorosa**. The **Rosary Walk** (the largest of its kind in America) offers a peaceful 35-minute walk with flower **gardens**, **natural areas**, bronze and marble handcrafted **statues**, and a **WWI outdoor grotto**.



12:10pm - Attend **Daily Mass**

1:00pm - **Lunch** on grounds from local favorites and visit the **gift shop**

1:45pm - Load bus and travel to **Missouri's National Veteran's Memorial**

2:00pm - Arrive at **Missouri's National Veteran's Memorial**

The awe-inspiring full-scale replica of the Vietnam Wall in Washington, D.C. offers a place for veterans and civilians to reflect on the sacrifices of service members. Tour the grounds with a guide and visit the museum and gift shop.



3:30pm - Load Bus and depart for **St. Louis**

5:00pm - Arrive back in **St. Louis**



† Day Three: Hermann



Enjoy a day of relaxation and peace as you visit **Hermann** and the nearby town of **Starkenbourg**, showcasing the **Shrine of Our Lady of Sorrows**, **St. Martin's Church Museum**, and the local flavors of **Missouri Wine Country**.

9:00am - Depart St. Louis and travel 80 miles west on I-70 to **Hermann, MO** or relax and travel by train on Amtrak (approximately 1.5 hours).

10:30am - 12:00pm - Tour the **Shrine of Our Lady of Sorrows**, **St. Martin's Church Museum**, along with the **Stations of the Cross** and grottoes on 40 beautiful acres.

12:15pm to 1:45pm - **Lunch in Hermann**

Savor a delicious meal at local restaurants like **Hermann Wurst Haus**, **Tin Mill Restaurant**, or **Vintage 1847 Restaurant**.

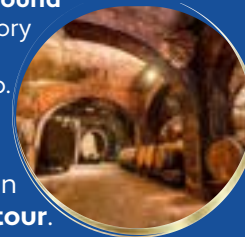


2:00pm - 3:30pm - **Stone Hill Winery**
Tour the largest series of arched, **underground cellars** in North America, with a rich history dating back to pre-Prohibition. Sample award-winning wines & visit the gift shop.

3:30pm - 5:00pm - Enjoy a **wine tasting** at **Hermannhof Winery**, then sip on your favorites in the fireplace room or patio. Try a self guided **cellar tour**.

5:00pm - 6:00pm - Dinner options include **Concert Hall & Barrel Bar**, **Zydeco**, or **Bunkers & Barrels**.

† Day Four: St. Louis



9:00am - 11:00am - Experience the **Gateway Arch** and gain a unique perspective of **St. Louis**. Start at the **Gateway Arch National Park**, explore the **Visitor's Center & Museum Under the Arch**, with exhibits spanning 200 years.



11:00am - 11:30am - Enjoy a box lunch on the beautiful grounds of the **Gateway Arch National Park**

12:10pm - (Optional) **Mass** at **Basilica of St. Louis**

1:00pm - 2:00pm - **Guided Tour** of the **Old Cathedral & Museum**. The Old Cathedral, built in 1834, is unique both in St. Louis & across America, combining a museum with artifacts from the early days of the Catholic Church & an active parish community.

2:00pm - 5:00pm - Explore **Grant's Farm**, starting with a tram ride through **Deer Park**, where you can observe a range of animals, including the magnificent **Budweiser Clydesdales**. Next, head to the **Bier Garden**, where you can enjoy a petting zoo, savor the food & beverages in **Bauernhof Courtyard**, and indulge in complimentary beer tastings.

6:30pm - Dinner at **Favazza's On The Hill**, in a historic Italian neighborhood.
