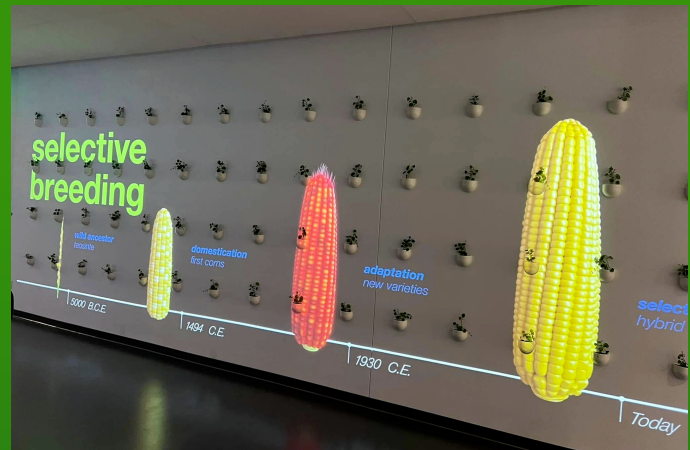

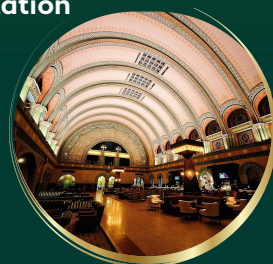


2:30pm - Tour of Anheuser Busch Brewery

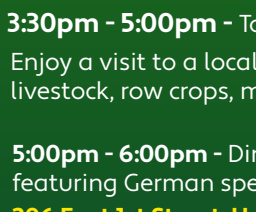
10:30am - 12:00pm - **Hermann Farm & Distillery**

9:00am - 11:30am - Experience the **Gateway Arch** **11 North 4th Street, St. Louis, MO, 63102**

Start at the **Gateway Arch National Park**, explore the **Visitor's Center & Museum Under the Arch**, with exhibits spanning 200 years. Take the tram to the top of the Gateway Arch for panoramic views. Enjoy the "**Monument to the Dream**" documentary.
